THIS IS THE LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT of me HENRY COCKROFT of
Glenedyth Lindale Road Grange over Sands in the county of Lancaster
Gentleman

1. I appoint James Wood of 141 Hainault Road Leytonstone and Joseph Edward Hodgson of Kendal in the county of Westmorland Draper hereinafter called "my trustees" EXECUTORS AND TRUSTEES of this my will
2. I give devise and bequeath all my real and personal estate unto my trustees Upon trust that my trustees shall (subject as hereinafter mentioned) sell call in and convert the same into money or such part thereof as shall not consist of money and shall with and out of the proceeds of such sale calling in and conversion and with and out of my ready money pay my funeral and testamentary expenses and debts and shall further pay thereout and I bequeath the following legacies namely
3. To the Treasurer for the time being of the Westmorland County Hospital in Kendal aforesaid the sum of one thousand pounds
4. To the Treasurer for the time being of the Port of Hull Societys Sailors Orphans Home one hundred pounds
5. To the Treasurer for the time being of the Whitby Cottage Hospital five hundred pounds
6. To my brother Abel Cockroft six hundred pounds To my nephews Thomas Cockroft Smith three hundred pounds William Duxbury three hundred pounds Ralph Cockroft three hundred pounds and Joseph Cockroft of Berwick six hundred pounds and to my niece Harriet Cleary three hundred pounds Florence Agnes Ann Critchlow three hundred pounds Eliza Ann Parkinson four hundred pounds Sarah Thomas three hundred pounds and Mary Cockroft Dobson four hundred pounds Provided always that in case of the death of my said brother or of any of my nephews or nieces hereinbefore named during my lifetime leaving a child or children him her or them surviving then I bequeath the legacy of such one or more so dying to such last mentioned child or children and if more than one in equal shares absolutely
7. To the two children of Annie Marston six hundred pounds jointly
8. To Charlotte Mary Cockroft (widow of my nephew John Cockroft) and her daughter Eva Rigg Cockroft the sum of eight hundred pounds jointly
9. To Fanny Sophia Storer and Eliza Mary Storer two hundred and fifty pounds jointly To Maud Whittle (of Glaisdale) Herbert Cleary and Charles Mac Conkey one hundred and twenty pounds each
10. To Frances Ogden and Clara Ogden of Summer Hill Kendal aforesaid To Mary Barrow and to her brother Thomas Barrow (children of the late Thomas Henry Barrow) To Mrs. Stevens of Sheen Park Richmond to Edith Lily Calkin To George Lansley of the Railway Clearing House to Tom Warren and to Robinson Cragg the sum of sixty pounds each
11. To the Servant who shall be in the house in which I am residing at the time of my decease twenty pounds
12. To my nephews Charles Henry Cockroft six hundred pounds and William Cockroft of Barrow in Furness one thousand pounds and to my niece Elizabeth Compston one thousand pounds Provided always that in case of the death of either of my said two nephews or of my niece during my lifetime leaving a child or children him her or them surviving then I bequeath the legacy of such one or more so dying to such last mentioned child or children and if more than one in equal shares absolutely
13. To the said James Wood and Joseph Edward Hodgson five hundred pounds each provided they act in the trusts of this my will
14. I direct that my trustees shall stand possessed of the residue of my estate In trust for and I give and bequeath the same to my nephew James Cockroft Smith absolutely
15. And lastly I empower my trustees to postpone for such period as they in their absolute and uncontrolled discretion shall think fit the sale and conversion of the whole or any part of my estate
16. I revoke all former wills made by me IN WITNESS whereof I have hereunto subscribed my name this thirty first day of January one thousand nine hundred and sixteen - H COCKROFT -
Signed by the said Testator Henry Cockroft as and for his last will and testament in the presence of us present at the same time who at his request in his presence and in the presence of each other have hereunto subscribed our names as witnesses - WILLIAM B LAND
