1851 census : living with son and a widower

1851 Census : Living at Lower Carr, Hunslet, Leeds.
Also living with them is an Eliza Atkinson who is listed as being an unmarried daughter-in-law aged 12

1851 and 61 census : George is a coal miner living at 5 Pettys Fold, Beeston, Leeds.

Just a guess that George is Williams son. Name appears as Dewxbury on birth records.

Dosent appear in 1851 census, has he died ?

Unsure that Mary (1829), Ann (1831) and Elizabeth (1834) are George's children but they are living with Ann at time of 1841 census.

Working in a Flax Mill in 1851

1851 Census : working in a woollen mill.
1861 Census : Coal miner and residing at home.

Two Henry's appear in 1851 and 1861 census with a 1 year discrepancy in birth, may be same person.

1851 Census : working in a woollen mill.
1861 Census : Woolen spinner, unmarried and living at home.

Family appear to disappear after 1861 but in the 1881 census George is given as Duxbury living with his son John (and family) a woollen spinner.
